

Tier 2 (Targeted) DE-PBS Project Supports At A Glance

Even with effective Tier 1 systems implemented with fidelity, some students will require more intensive supports. The Delaware Positive Behavior Support Project offers team training in Tier 2 Supports for schools that have an established Tier 1 system. This training focuses on **two types of conversations necessary for effective Tier 2 system.**

System Conversations

Teams are taught to use and collect behavior data as well as how to evaluate overall effectiveness of Tier 2 interventions.

Problem Solving Conversations

Teams are taught to match students to interventions, monitor progress, and make adjustments to interventions for students.

Information is provided to help school teams develop a system to identify students at-risk for academic and/or behavioral concerns and quickly implement interventions.

Hallmarks of Effective Tier 2 Behavior Intervention Programming:

- There is a Tier 2 team with behavioral expertise established at a school to monitor Tier 2 system & student progress within interventions.
- Information about all Tier 2 interventions and outcomes is shared with all staff regularly and is well understood.
- Data is used to identify students in need of supports and to monitor student progress and intervention fidelity.
- Tier 2 Team has ongoing communication with Tier 1 (school-wide) PBS team and vice versa.
- Tier 2 interventions used in a school are:
 - Efficient
 - Match the function of students' behaviors
 - Continuously available
 - Aligned with school-wide expectations
 - Designed to support multiple students simultaneously
 - Effectively documented

Tier 2 Data Tracking

The DE-PBS Project helps schools to create systems to organize their Tier 2 interventions, monitor them and assess them for fidelity and successful outcomes. Tracking tools and documentation are important aspects in those systems. Below is more information about the data tracking tool the DE-PBS Project provides to schools.*

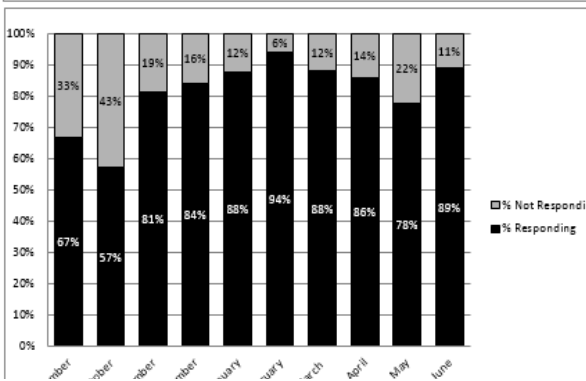

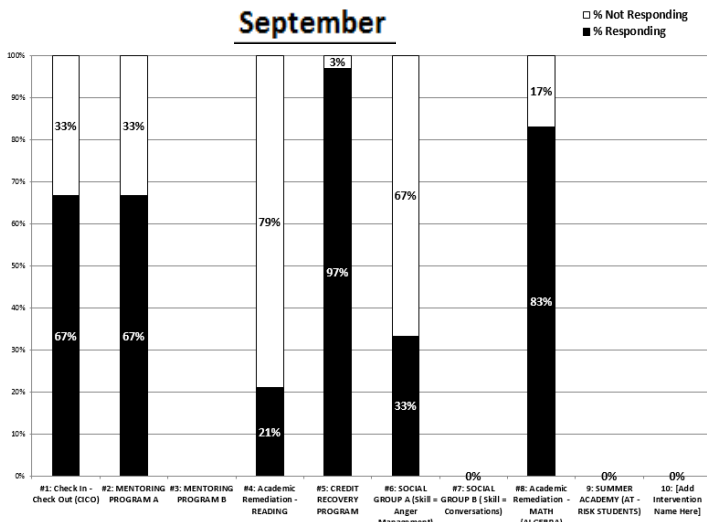
