
- This mistake is helping you understand so many more things about math! I love how you care about your work!

- Trying to find new information about your writing topic is a great way to get over your writer's block. I like how you asked for help to get new ideas!
- This math problem can be tricky. Let's try again. What are some other strategies that you haven't tried yet?



- If you are feeling frustrated, it is ok to go to the "Take a Break" area.
- I noticed it was hard for you to work in your group today. Let's talk about some teamwork strategies during center time so you are ready to care about others.
- Let's use this picture cue on your desk to help you remember to raise your hand, and I will give you a "thumbs up" when I see your hand up. I love how you are ready to share your ideas!
- When you line up without pushing, you are being a leader!
