

In the 2020-2021 School Year over ...

- **26,204** students
- **6,108** staff
- **6,088** families

...participated in the surveys from across the state.

## 2020-2021 SY statewide results tell us ...

- 93.3% students reported that they try their best in school.
- 85.6% of teachers/staff surveyed noted teachers, staff & administrators function as a good team.
- 93.2% of students, 98.8% of staff & 94.8% of guardians surveyed reported that teachers care about their students.
- **69.7**% of surveyed high school students, **72.5**% of middle school students & **88.6**% of elementary school students agreed that students care about each other.
- **94.5**% of students, **94.9**% of teachers & **95.3**% of guardians surveyed reported that teachers treat students of all races with respect.
- 86.0% of parents surveyed agreed that teachers do a good job communicating with parents.
